A RESOLUTION

- 1 Expressing regret on the passing of Thomas Hubert Dollar; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Thomas Hubert Dollar, a lifetime resident of Decatur County, graduated from
3 Bainbridge High School and the University of Georgia; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he was a successful and innovative agribusinessman, president of Dollar Farm
5 Products and Decatur Gin Company; a director and vice chairman of Chem-Nut, Inc., a
6 chemical co-op; a founding director of Bainbridge National Bank; a member of the National
7 Peanut Board; and he established the first cotton gin in the county; and
- 8 WHEREAS, he was honored as Agriculture Man of the Year in 1989; and
- 9 WHEREAS, he provided invaluable leadership in civic organizations, serving as president
10 of the Bainbridge Jaycees and the Bainbridge Shrine Club, and as an active member of Orion
11 Lodge # 8, F.&A.M., Hasan Shrine Temple; and
- 12 WHEREAS, his outstanding career as a public servant included service as a member of the
13 Bainbridge City Council from 1961 to 1965, as representative to the General Assembly from
14 1965 to 1968, and as mayor of Bainbridge from 1973 to 1978; and
- 15 WHEREAS, he and his wife, Abbie Anderson Dollar, reared a fine family of two children,
16 Tommy Dollar and Tamara Dollar Hader, and they had three grandchildren; and
- 17 WHEREAS, he was a devout member of the First Baptist Church; and
- 18 WHEREAS, his many contributions have enriched his community and the state.
- 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
20 express sincere regret on the passing of Thomas Hubert Dollar, exemplary citizen.
