## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Article 1 of Chapter 4 of Title 32 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
relating to state, county, and municipal road systems, so as to prohibit the naming or
renaming of public roads and bridges for any living current or former elected public official;
to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.
