A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 1 of Article 2 of Chapter 7 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to criminal trespass and damage to property generally, so as to create the
- 3 crime of possession of tools for committing the crimes of criminal trespass and criminal
- 4 damage to property in the second degree; to change the penalty provisions relating to the
- 5 offenses of criminal trespass and criminal damage to property in the second degree; to
- 6 provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Part 1 of Article 2 of Chapter 7 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 10 relating to criminal trespass and damage to property generally, is amended by adding a new
- 11 Code Section 16-7-20.1 to follow Code Section 16-7-20 to read as follows:
- 12 "16-7-20.1.
- 13 (a) A person commits the offense of possession of tools for the commission of the crime
- of criminal trespass or criminal damage to property in the second degree when a person has
- in that person's possession any aerosol spray paint can, aerosol spray paint can tip, broad
- tip marker, or other device commonly used in the commission of the crime of criminal
- 17 trespass or criminal damage to property in the second degree with the intent to make use
- thereof in the commission of the crime of criminal trespass or criminal damage to property
- in the second degree.
- 20 (b) A person convicted of the offense of possession of tools for the commission of the
- 21 crime of criminal trespass or criminal damage to property in the second degree shall be
- 22 punished as for a misdemeanor.
- 23 (c) A court sentencing a person convicted of possession of tools for the commission of the
- crime of criminal trespass or criminal damage to property in the second degree may require
- as a condition of probation, suspension of sentence, or community service that the person
- 26 convicted participate in a community justice program involving the admission of guilt,

working to undo the effects of the offense, and taking steps to convince the community that

2 the crime will not happen again."

3 SECTION 2.

4 Said part is further amended by adding a new subsection (e) to Code Section 16-7-21,

- 5 relating to criminal trespass, to read as follows:
- 6 "(e) A court sentencing a person convicted of criminal trespass involving damage to
- 7 property shall impose restitution as required by Code Section 17-14-17 and may require
- 8 as a condition of probation, suspension of sentence, or community service that the person
- 9 convicted participate in a community justice program involving the admission of guilt,
- working to undo the effects of the offense, and taking steps to convince the community that
- 11 the crime will not happen again."

12 SECTION 3.

- 13 Said part is further amended by striking Code Section 16-7-23, relating to criminal damage
- 14 to property in the second degree, in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 15 "16-7-23.
- 16 (a) A person commits the offense of criminal damage to property in the second degree
- when he or she:
- 18 (1) Intentionally damages any property of another person without his <u>or her</u> consent and
- the damage thereto exceeds \$500.00;
- 20 (2) Recklessly or intentionally, by means of fire or explosive, damages property of
- another person; or
- 22 (3) With intent to damage, starts a fire on the land of another without his <u>or her</u> consent.
- 23 (b) A person convicted of the offense of criminal damage to property in the second degree
- shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than one nor more than five years.
- 25 (c) A court sentencing a person convicted of criminal damage to property in the second
- 26 <u>degree shall impose restitution as required by Code Section 17-14-17 and may require as</u>
- 27 <u>a condition of probation, suspension of sentence, or community service that the person</u>
- 28 convicted participate in a community justice program involving the admission of guilt,
- 29 working to undo the effects of the offense, and taking steps to convince the community that
- 30 the crime will not happen again."

31 SECTION 4.

32 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
