## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 32-4-22 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 creation of the Developmental Highway System, so as to change the description of road
- 3 corridors included within such system; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1.

- 6 Code Section 32-4-22 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to creation of the
- 7 Developmental Highway System, is amended by striking subsection (a) and inserting in lieu
- 8 thereof the following:
- 9 "(a) There is created as a part of the state highway system a system of public roads to be
- 10 known as the Developmental Highway System which shall consist of the following road
- 11 corridors (not in order of priority):
- 12 (1) Appalachian;
- 13 (2) The South Georgia Parkway;
- 14 (3) U.S. 27;
- 15 (4) U.S. 82;
- 16 (5) Golden Isles;
- 17 (6) Savannah River;
- 18 (7) U.S. 441;
- 19 (8) Fall Line;
- 20 (9) U.S. 319;
- 21 (10) U.S. 19;
- 22 (11) U.S. 84;
- 23 (12) U.S. 1/SR 17;
- 24 (13) SR 72;
- 25 (14) Outer Perimeter;
- 26 (15) East-west Highway from I-59 North to I-85 North; and

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- 1 (16) Truck access routes and SR 133 from Albany to Valdosta;
- 2 (17) SR 32; and
- 3 (18) SR 40 between St. Marys and Kingsland.
- 4 <u>Without limiting the foregoing, said</u> system is further identified as being <u>including</u> those
- 5 roads and corridors referred to as 'the Governor's Road Improvement Program' in that
- 6 resolution adopted by the State Transportation Board dated November 17, 1988."

## 7 SECTION 2.

8 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
