## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 21-2-417 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 identification of voters at the polls, so as to require photographic identification of voters at
- 3 the polling places prior to voting and to eliminate the ability to submit an affidavit in lieu of
- 4 presenting a valid form of identification; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting
- 5 laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 21-2-417 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to identification
- 9 of voters at the polls, is amended by striking said Code section in its entirety and inserting
- in lieu thereof the following:

- 12 (a) Each elector shall present proper identification to a poll worker at or prior to
- completion of a voter's certificate at any polling place and prior to such person's admission
- to the enclosed space at such polling place. Proper identification shall consist of any one
- of the following:
- 16 (1) A valid Georgia driver's license;
- 17 (2) A valid identification card <u>containing a photograph of the elector and</u> issued by a
- branch, department, agency, or entity of the State of Georgia, any other state, or the
- 19 United States authorized by law to issue personal identification;
- 20 (3) A valid United States passport;
- 21 (4) A valid employee identification card containing a photograph of the elector and
- issued by any branch, department, agency, or entity of the United States government, this
- state, or any county, municipality, board, authority, or other entity of this state;
- 24 (5) A valid employee identification card containing a photograph of the elector and
- issued by any employer of the elector in the ordinary course of such employer's business;

1 (6) A valid student identification card containing a photograph of the elector from any

- 2 public or private college, university, or postgraduate technical or professional school
- 3 located within the State of Georgia; or
- 4 (7) A valid Georgia hunting or fishing license;
- 5 (8) A valid Georgia license to carry a pistol or revolver;
- 6 (9) A valid pilot's license issued by the Federal Aviation Administration or other
- 7 authorized agency of the United States;
- 8 (10) (7) A valid United States military identification card <u>containing a photograph of the</u>
- 9 <u>elector.</u>;
- 10 (11) A certified copy of the elector's birth certificate;
- 11 (12) A valid social security card;
- 12 (13) Certified naturalization documentation; or
- 13 (14) A certified copy of court records showing adoption, name, or sex change.
- 14 (b) If an elector is unable to produce any of the items of identification listed in subsection
- 15 (a) of this Code section, he or she shall sign a statement under oath in a form approved by
- 16 the Secretary of State, separate and distinct from the elector's voter certificate, swearing or
- 17 affirming that he or she is the person identified on the elector's voter certificate. Such person
- shall be allowed to vote without undue delay. Falsely swearing or affirming such statement
- 19 under oath shall be punishable as a felony, and the penalty shall be distinctly set forth on the
- 20 face of the statement."
- 21 SECTION 2.
- 22 This Act shall become effective on the first day of January following the date on which this
- 23 Act is approved by the Governor or becomes law without such approval.
- SECTION 3.
- 25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
