A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 6A of Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the  
2 Criminal Justice Coordinating Council, so as to change the assignment for administrative  
3 purposes; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 **SECTION 1.**

6 Chapter 6A of Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Criminal  
7 Justice Coordinating Council, is amended by striking Code Section 35-6A-2, relating to  
8 assignment, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

9 "35-6A-2.

10 There is established the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council of the State of Georgia  
11 which is assigned to the ~~Office of Planning and Budget~~ Georgia Bureau of Investigation  
12 for administrative purposes only, as prescribed in Code Section 50-4-3."

13 **SECTION 2.**

14 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law  
15 without such approval.

16 **SECTION 3.**

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
