A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend an Act establishing the Board of Public Education and Orphanage for Bibb
- 2 County, approved August 23, 1872 (Ga. L. 1872, p. 388), as amended, particularly by an Act
- 3 approved April 2, 1992 (Ga. L. 1992, p. 5264), so as to change provisions relating to the
- 4 certification and levy of the school tax; to delete a provision which requires the board of
- 5 education to furnish a copy of the final school budget to the board of county commissioners
- 6 for its review and approval; to provide for a referendum; to provide for an effective date; to
- 7 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 SECTION 1.

- 10 An Act establishing the Board of Public Education and Orphanage for Bibb County,
- approved August 23, 1872 (Ga. L. 1872, p. 388), as amended, particularly by an Act
- 12 approved April 2, 1992 (Ga. L. 1992, p. 5264), is amended by striking Section 3 of said Act
- and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

14 "SECTION 3.

- 15 (a) The board shall be entitled to and shall receive for the purposes of this Act the pro rata
- share for Bibb County of all taxes now paid to the state and set apart for educational
- purposes and all appropriations for such purposes and the pro rata share for Bibb County
- of all endowments, devises, gifts, and bequests made, or hereafter to be made, to the state
- or State Board of Education and of any and all educational incomes and funds not
- belonging to and due to the board of regents now in the treasury of the state or hereafter to
- 21 be deposited.

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- 22 (b) The board of education shall annually certify to the Board of Commissioners of Bibb
- County a school tax for the support and maintenance of education in Bibb County. The
- board of commissioners shall annually levy said tax upon the assessed value of all taxable

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1 property within Bibb County and collect the same like other taxes of the county. The levy

- 2 made by the board of education and certified to the board of commissioners shall not
- 3 exceed 20 mills per dollar unless such mill limitation shall be increased or removed in the
- 4 manner provided by law."

5 SECTION 2.

- 6 Said Act is further amended by striking Section 3A in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof
- 7 the following:
- 8 "SECTION 3A.
- 9 Reserved."

SECTION 3.

- 11 Unless prohibited by the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended, the election
- superintendent of Bibb County shall call and conduct an election as provided in this section
- 13 for the purpose of submitting this Act to the voters of Bibb County for approval or rejection.
- 14 The election superintendent shall conduct that election on the date of the November, 2002,
- 15 general election and shall issue the call and conduct the election as provided by general law.
- 16 The superintendent shall cause the date and purpose of the election to be published once a
- 17 week for two weeks immediately preceding the date thereof in the official organ of Bibb
- 18 County. The ballot shall have printed thereon the words:
- 19 "() YES Shall the Act be approved which changes the provisions of law relating to
- 20 the certification and levy of the school tax by the Bibb County Board of
- 21 () NO Education?"
- 22 All persons desiring to vote for approval of the Act shall vote "Yes," and those persons
- 23 desiring to vote for rejection of the Act shall vote "No." If more than one-half of the votes
- 24 cast on such question are for approval of the Act, it shall become of full force and effect on
- 25 the first day of January immediately following that election date. If the Act is not so
- approved or if the election is not conducted as provided in this section, the Act shall not
- become effective and shall be automatically repealed on the first day of January immediately
- 28 following that election date.
- 29 **SECTION 4.**
- 30 Except as otherwise provided in Section 3 of this Act, this Act shall become effective upon
- 31 its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.

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1 SECTION 5.

2 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
