A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 40-5-57 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the

- 2 suspension or revocation of the licenses of habitually negligent or dangerous drivers and to
- 3 the point system, so as to provide for the assessment of points for a violation of Code Section
- 4 40-6-241, relating to the use of radios and mobile telephones while driving; to amend Code
- 5 Section 40-6-241 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the exercise of due
- 6 care by drivers and the allowance for proper use of radios and mobile telephones, so as to
- 7 provide that a driver who is involved in an accident while using a mobile telephone shall be
- 8 in violation of said Code section; to provide a penalty; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
- 9 other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

11 **SECTION 1.** 12 Code Section 40-5-57 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the suspension 13 or revocation of the licenses of habitually negligent or dangerous drivers and to the point 14 system, is amended by striking subparagraph (c)(1)(A) and inserting in lieu thereof the 15 following: "(c)(1)(A) Except as provided in subparagraph (C) of this paragraph, the points to be 16 17 assessed for each offense shall be as provided in the following schedule: 18 Reckless driving 4 points 19 Unlawful passing of a school bus 6 points 20 4 points Improper passing on a hill or a curve 21 Exceeding the speed limit by more than 14 miles per hour but less than 19 22 miles per hour 2 points 23 Exceeding the speed limit by 19 miles per hour or more but less than 24 24 miles per hour 3 points

16	of due care by drivers and the allowance for the proper use of radios and mobile telepl	nones,
17	is amended by striking said Code section in its entirety and inserting in lieu there	of the
18	following:

20	A driver shall exercise due care in operating a motor vehicle on the highways of thi	s state
21	and shall not engage in any actions which shall distract such driver from the safe ope	ration
22	of such vehicle, provided that the proper use of a radio, citizens band radio, or r	nobile
23	telephone shall not be a violation of this Code section. Any use of a mobile telephone	one by
24	a driver while he or she operates a moving motor vehicle and which use is determine	<u>ied by</u>
25	law enforcement officers to be a contributing factor in any accident resulting in ph	ysical
26	injury or property damage shall be a violation of this Code section which shall be pur	<u>nished</u>
27	by a fine of \$50.00 and which shall result in the assessment of points under Code S	<u>ection</u>
28	<u>40-5-57."</u>
