A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 16-12-1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 contributing to the delinquency, unruliness, or deprivation of a minor, so as to change
- 3 provisions for committing said offense and defenses to said offense; to provide for related
- 4 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 16-12-1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to contributing to
- 8 the delinquency, unruliness, or deprivation of a minor, is amended by striking paragraph (1)
- 9 of subsection (b) in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new paragraph (1) to read as
- 10 follows:

- 11 "(1) Knowingly and willfully encourages, causes, abets, connives, or aids a minor in
- committing a delinquent act or soliciting a minor to commit a delinquent act as such is
- defined in Code Section 15-11-2, relating to juvenile proceedings;"

14 SECTION 2.

- 15 Said Code section is further amended by striking subsection (c) in its entirety and inserting
- in lieu thereof a new subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 17 "(c) It shall not be a defense to the offense provided for in this Code section that the minor
- has not been formally adjudged to have committed a delinquent act or has not committed
- 19 <u>the act which was solicited</u> or has not been found to be unruly or deprived."

SECTION 3.

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
