## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 12 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to general provisions relative to offenses against public health and morals, so as to
- 3 define the offense of failing to supervise a minor; to provide for punishment; to repeal
- 4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article 1 of Chapter 12 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 8 general provisions relative to offenses against public health and morals, is amended by
- 9 adding a new Code Section 16-12-1.2 to read as follows:
- 10 "16-12-1.2.

- 11 (a) A person commits the offense of failing to supervise a minor when:
- 12 (1) Such person is the minor's parent or guardian; and
- 13 (2) The minor, after having committed any of the following acts, subsequently:
- (A) Commits any act which would be a misdemeanor of a high and aggravated nature
- if committed by an adult;
- 16 (B) Commits any act which would be a felony if committed by an adult; or
- 17 (C) Violates a curfew established by ordinance or resolution of any city, county, or consolidated government.
- 19 (b) It shall not be a defense to the offense of failing to supervise a minor that the minor has
- 20 not been formally adjudged to have committed a delinquent act nor has been found to be
- 21 unruly or deprived.
- 22 (c) A person convicted of the offense of failing to supervise a minor shall be guilty of a
- 23 misdemeanor and shall be punished by not less than 40 nor more than 80 hours of
- 24 community service. Such community service shall be supervised under such terms and
- conditions as the judge shall impose."
