A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To amend Chapter 11 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2	emergency services, so as to include providers of emergency prehospital health care and
3	emergency medical transportation within the definition of emergency medical provider; to
4	include the services of such providers within the definition of emergency services; to provide
5	for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
7	SECTION 1.
8	Chapter 11 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to emergency
9	services, is amended by striking paragraphs (2) and (3) of Code Section 31-11-81, relating
10	to definitions, in their entirety and inserting in lieu thereof new paragraphs (2) and (3) to read
11	as follows:
12	"(2) 'Emergency medical provider' means any provider of emergency prehospital health
13	care or emergency medical transportation licensed or permitted by the Georgia
14	Department of Human Resources, hospital licensed or permitted by the Georgia
15	Department of Human Resources, hospital based service, or physician licensed by the
16	Composite State Board of Medical Examiners who provides emergency services.

17 (3) 'Emergency services' means <u>emergency prehospital health care, emergency medical</u>
18 <u>transportation, or health care services provided in a hospital emergency facility to</u>

- 19 evaluate and treat any emergency condition."

SECTION 2.

This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming lawwithout such approval.
