A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to crimes, so as to
- 2 change the definition of aggravated assault; to create the new offense of aggravated sexual
- 3 assault and provide penalties; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and
- 4 for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating crimes, is amended in Code
- 8 Section 16-5-21, relating to aggravated assault, by striking paragraph (1) of subsection (a)
- 9 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 10 "(1) With intent to murder, to rape, or to rob;"
- 11 SECTION 2.
- 12 Said title is further amended by inserting after Code Section 16-6-3, relating to statutory rape,
- 13 a new Code Section 16-6-3.1 to read as follows:
- 14 "16-6-3.1.
- 15 (a) A person commits the offense of aggravated sexual assault when:
- 16 (1) He or she assaults another with the intent to commit rape, aggravated sodomy, or
- aggravated sexual battery; or
- 18 (2) He has carnal knowledge of a female when a reasonable person would know that the
- female does not consent. Carnal knowledge under this Code section occurs when there
- is any penetration of the female sex organ by the male sex organ.
- 21 (b) A person convicted of the offense of aggravated sexual assault shall be punished by
- imprisonment for not less than one nor more than 20 years."
- SECTION 3.
- 24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
