A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Third Day; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Third Day is a Christian band making music for a non-Christian world; and
- 3 WHEREAS, the band started out playing Atlanta church basements eight years ago, taking
4 their name from the day that Jesus rose from the grave after crucifixion; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the band has earned a third consecutive Grammy Award and was named one
6 of the Top 10 contemporary Christian artists; and
- 7 WHEREAS, their new album, "Offerings," featuring a distinctive blend of southern rock,
8 husky vocals, and the fervor of tent revivals, is approaching gold status; and
- 9 WHEREAS, contemporary Christian music sells more than jazz, classical, and New Age
10 music combined; and
- 11 WHEREAS, despite criticism, band members Mac Powell, Mark Lee, Tai Anderson, David
12 Carr, and Brad Avery say they won't retreat from proclaiming their faith.
