A RESOLUTION

- 1 Expressing regrets at the passing of Robert James Disharoon; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, on January 13, 2001, Fayette County and the State of Georgia lost a
3 distinguished citizen with the passing of Robert James Disharoon; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he was born on July 6, 1933, in Rossville, Georgia, served with distinction as
5 a member of the U. S. Army for four years, and worked in the Engineering Department of
6 the City of Atlanta for several years; and
- 7 WHEREAS, he enjoyed a long career with Tri-City Realty & Mortgage, Inc., where he
8 served as president since 1962, and earned a reputation for his honesty, integrity,
9 commitment to serving as a mentor, and talent for listening to people and their concerns; and
- 10 WHEREAS, he was a long-time member and a past president of the Fayette County Board
11 of Realtors, served as president of the Georgia Association of Realtors in 1984, served as a
12 director of Georgia MLS, served as chairman of the Fayette County Chamber of Commerce
13 in 1980, was named Business Person of the Year in 1981, worked for many years as
14 chairman of the committee to bring a hospital to Fayette County, and was the first chairman
15 of the Fayette County Development Authority; and
- 16 WHEREAS, he was an active member of the Airport Rotary Club, helped form the
17 Fayetteville Rotary Club, served as its president in 1981-82, and had a record of 25 years of
18 perfect attendance; and
- 19 WHEREAS, he was an active member of Kenwood Christian Church, where he served as an
20 elder and trustee, was the building program supervisor, and oversaw the landscaping, and
21 served as a member of the Board of Trustees of Atlanta Christian College; and

1 WHEREAS, he was an outstanding role model to young people, having served as chairman
2 of the Fayette County District of the Boy Scouts of America and as a director of the Fayette
3 County Youth Protection Home; and

4 WHEREAS, he was the devoted husband of Mrs. Nell West Disharoon and was a beloved
5 father, grandfather, and great-grandfather.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
7 the members of this body express their deepest regrets at the passing of Robert James
8 Disharoon and extend their sincerest sympathy to the members of his family.
