

Senate Bill 215

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 16 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,  
2 relating to general provisions relative to state property, so as to prohibit the naming or  
3 renaming of state property for any living elected public official; to provide an effective date;  
4 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Article 1 of Chapter 16 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
8 general provisions relative to state property, is amended by adding at the end thereof a new  
9 Code section to read as follows:  
10 "50-16-19.

11 On and after July 1, 2001, no property owned by the state including, but not limited to,  
12 state parks, buildings, highways, roads, or bridges, shall be officially designated or  
13 redesignated by any state agency or state official by the name and in honor of any living  
14 elected public official and no signs or markers shall be erected which so designate any such  
15 state owned property."

16 **SECTION 2.**

17 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2001.

18 **SECTION 3.**

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
