A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Honorable Woodson Daniel; and for other purposes.

3 Pulaski County where he has served with the utmost distinction as the Clerk of Superior
4 Court from January, 1961, through December, 2000, a period of 40 years; and

14 Antioch Baptist Church, a loving partner to his wife, Allene T. Daniel, an understanding
15 parent to two adult children, and a wonderful grandfather to four very fortunate children.
