A RESOLUTION

- 1 Expressing regret at the passing of Anne Sheppard; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, on February 13, 2001, the State of Georgia lost one of its finest and most
3 distinguished citizens with the untimely passing of Anne Sheppard; and
- 4 WHEREAS, she devoted her life to her community through her many years of service to the
5 citizens of Carrollton, Carroll County, and the State of Georgia; and
- 6 WHEREAS, this beloved lady was actively involved in the civic, religious, and charitable
7 affairs of her community and gave unstintingly and unceasingly of her time, talents, and
8 energy to improve the quality of life in her community, as dramatically evidenced by her
9 many years of work as a middle school teacher; her accomplishments in the sixteen years that
10 she served on the Carrollton City Council, including the development of parks, the
11 implementation of community policing, the establishment of a housing authority officer, a
12 school resource officer, a D.A.R.E. program officer, and a crime prevention officer; and her
13 membership on the Salvation Army Board, the Southwire Advisory Board, and the Board of
14 the United Methodist Church; and
- 15 WHEREAS, her unparalleled organizational and leadership talents, her remarkable patience
16 and diplomacy, her keen sense of vision, and her acute sensitivity to the needs of the citizens
17 of her community earned her the respect and admiration of her colleagues and associates; and
- 18 WHEREAS, the untimely passing of this generous, unselfish, and devoted family woman
19 leaves an unfillable void in the hearts and lives of her family and friends.
- 20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
21 express their deepest and most sincere regret at the passing of Anne Sheppard.
