14 WHEREAS, the parade is held in the lovely historic district of downtown Savannah and each

15 year hundreds of thousands of visiting celebrants are irresistibly attracted by the city's charm

16 and its wonderful hospitality; and

WHEREAS, eagerly awaited each year, it is a grand and glorious occasion for the citizensof Savannah, Chatham County, and the State of Georgia.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY SENATE that this body recognizes and
honors the Chairman Ted Robertson, the Grand Marshal, and other representatives of the
