- 16 scout masters are Jeff Evett, Randy Crane, Ray Logsdon, and John Cooper; and
- 17 WHEREAS, the members of Boy Scout Troop 535 are Cory Borst, Andy Vickery, Ian
- 18 Vickery, Chris Cooper, Jason Kien, Nick Logsdon, Sean Evett, and Russell Crane.
- 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 20 the leaders and members of Boy Scout Troop 535 are recognized and commended for their
- 21 service, dedication, courage, and efforts in their rescue of Ms. Tannis Blackwell on March
- 22 18, 2000.
