5 Seabrooks and was the fourth child of five offspring, and he was baptized at an early age and
6 became an active member of South Valley Missionary Baptist Church for his entire life; and
- 7 WHEREAS, in 1940, he met and married Annie B. Baker and they became the proud parents
8 of three children; and following his service in World War II from May 10, 1944, until
9 November 7, 1945, he worked for Hercules Incorporated for over 41 years; and
- 10 WHEREAS, he was ordained as a Deacon of South Valley Missionary Baptist Church,
11 served as president of the Senior Choir, and ably led the finance committee as chairman until
12 his health failed; and
- 13 WHEREAS, his wide circle of family and friends were greatly influenced by his generosity,
14 kindness, and encouragement and they will cherish his memory forever.
