A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Bebe Heiskell; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Bebe Heiskell has long been recognized by the citizens of Walker County for
3 the vital role that she has played in community leadership and her deep personal commitment
4 to the welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and
- 5 WHEREAS, she has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of her time,
6 talents, and energy toward the betterment of her community and state, as evidenced
7 dramatically by her years of service as county administrator for Walker County; and
- 8 WHEREAS, she was elected sole commissioner of Walker County in the November 2000
9 General Election, making her the first female sole county commissioner in the history of
10 Georgia; and
- 11 WHEREAS, her significant organizational and leadership talents, her remarkable patience
12 and diplomacy, her keen sense of vision, and her sensitivity to the needs of the citizens of her
13 community have earned her the respect and admiration of her colleagues and associates; and
- 14 WHEREAS, she is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for
15 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and
- 16 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
17 distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
- 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that Bebe Heiskell is
19 recognized and commended for her efficient, effective, unselfish, and dedicated public
20 service to the citizens of her community and state and for her history making election as the
21 first female sole county commissioner in Georgia.
