A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 exemptions from sales and use tax, so as to change provisions relating to the state sales and
- 3 use tax exemption for packaging materials; to provide for conditions and limitations; to
- 4 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to exemptions from
- 8 sales and use tax, is amended by striking division (35)(A)(iii) and inserting in its place a new
- 9 division (35)(A)(iii) to read as follows:
- 10 "(iii) Materials, containers, labels, sacks, or bags used for packaging tangible personal
- property for shipment or sale. To qualify for the packaging exemption, the items shall
- be used solely for packaging and shall not be purchased for reuse, unless the reusable
- packaging is rented from a third party who is the owner of the packaging materials
- and not the processor, manufacturer, or converter of the shipped tangible personal

SECTION 2.

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
