### A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending First Georgia Dowsers; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, First Georgia Dowsers has operated as a resource for training those interested  
3 in the techniques of dowsing; and
- 4 WHEREAS, dowsing is an effective method for locating water and minerals and is used in  
5 personal health applications and other specialities; and
- 6 WHEREAS, dowsing methodology has been used by many cultures worldwide, dating to  
7 antiquity; and
- 8 WHEREAS, First Georgia Dowsers is affiliated with the American Society of Dowsers,  
9 being among the largest and most active local groups; and
- 10 WHEREAS, during the previous five months, First Georgia Dowsers has contributed one  
11 thousand dollars to the Water for Humanity Fund, which assists in providing potable drinking  
12 water for developing countries and during emergency relief situations; and
- 13 WHEREAS, the contribution will provide a very significant percentage of the typical grant  
14 issued by the fund; and
- 15 WHEREAS, First Georgia Dowsers provides an educational function by hosting lectures on  
16 many diverse subjects and operating a library specializing in difficult-to-obtain material; and
- 17 WHEREAS, one of the past presidents, Tom Crawford, accomplished innovative research  
18 during his tenure in the group and also was elected to national office on the board of the  
19 American Society of Dowsers.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
2 commend the members and officers of First Georgia Dowers for their ongoing efforts to  
3 advance the understanding and advocate the practice of dowsing.
