1 Honoring Mrs. Frances Evans; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, on Tuesday, March 6, 2001, at the Old Georgia Railroad Depot in Atlanta, Mrs.
3 Frances Evans will receive the Governor's Award in the Humanities at a public ceremony;
4 and

5 WHEREAS, the Governor's Award in the Humanities recognizes exemplary achievements
6 that have fostered an understanding of our cultural traditions and values in Georgia and have
7 thus strengthened community, character, and citizenship in our state; and

8 WHEREAS, Mrs. Evans is being honored for her work with the Institute for Continuing
9 Learning at Young Harris College, which she cofounded in 1991; and

10 WHEREAS, in addition she is active in the community as a member of the Friends of the
11 Libraries and a local book club and discussion group; and

12 WHEREAS, she helps provide a weekly music class for students at the Towns County
13 Elementary School in Young Harris; and

14 WHEREAS, Mrs. Evans has participated in over 50 Elderhostels both foreign and domestic
15 and as the In-house Coordinator for the Elderhostel program held at Young Harris College;

17 WHEREAS, she has served for many years as the class coordinator for the Disciples Sunday
18 School Class at Sharp Memorial United Methodist Church; and

19 WHEREAS, a native of Chattanooga, Tennessee, Mrs. Evans retired to Young Harris 20
20 years ago.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
2 this body commends Mrs. Frances Evans for her work with the Institute for Continuing
3 Learning at Young Harris College and congratulates her on receiving the Governor's Award
