A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing John Robert Goldin and designating a portion of State Highway 120 in Haralson
2 County as the Bobby Goldin Highway; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, John Robert Goldin, known as Bobby Goldin, was born on December 10, 1930,
4 in Haralson County, Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Goldin attended the public schools of Haralson County, graduating in 1948,
6 and graduated from West Georgia College in 1950; and

7 WHEREAS, he was employed with the Lockheed Aircraft Company from 1951 through
8 1972 when he went into business as a supermarket owner and operator; and

9 WHEREAS, in 1974 he founded Draketown Gas, serving as President of the company until
10 1992 when it merged with the Atlanta Gas Light Company; and

11 WHEREAS, Mr. Goldin played a leading role in establishing the Union Fire Department, has
12 been an active supporter of Haralson County High School and youth recreation teams,
13 served on the Haralson County Water Authority, served as President of the Haralson County
14 Chamber of Commerce, and has exhibited leadership in other community and civic activities
15 too numerous to list here; and

16 WHEREAS, it is appropriate to recognize Mr. Goldin for his many important contributions
17 to his community and the State of Georgia.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 GEORGIA that the portion of Georgia Highway 120 in Haralson County between Corinth
20 Church and Rose's Store is hereby designated as the Bobby Goldin Highway.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is directed to erect and
2 maintain appropriate signs marking the Bobby Goldin Highway.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House is authorized and directed to
4 transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to Mr. Bobby Goldin.
