## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 16-8-41 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 armed robbery, robbery by intimidation, and taking a controlled substance from a pharmacy
- 3 in the course of committing offense, so as to provide that one commits the offense of armed
- 4 robbery when, with the intent to commit theft, he or she threatens another person by use of
- 5 an offensive weapon, or any replica, article, or device having the appearance of such weapon,
- 6 for the purpose of taking the property of another from such other person or from the
- 7 immediate presence of such other person; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.** 

- 10 Code Section 16-8-41 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to armed robbery,
- 11 robbery by intimidation, and taking a controlled substance from a pharmacy in the course of
- 12 committing offense, is amended by striking in its entirety subsection (a) and inserting in lieu
- 13 thereof the following:
- 14 "(a) A person commits the offense of armed robbery when, with intent to commit theft, he
- or she takes property of another from the person or the immediate presence of another by
- use of an offensive weapon, or any replica, article, or device having the appearance of such
- 17 weapon. A person also commits the offense of armed robbery when, with the intent to
- 18 <u>commit theft</u>, he or she immediately threatens another person by use of an offensive
- weapon, or any replica, article, or device having the appearance of such weapon, for the
- 20 <u>purpose of taking the property of another from such other person or from the immediate</u>
- 21 <u>presence of such other person.</u> The offense of robbery by intimidation shall be a lesser
- included offense in the offense of armed robbery."

SECTION 2.

24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
