

Senate Bill 260

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating the board of commissioners of Clayton County, approved February
2 8, 1955 (Ga. L. 1955, p. 2064), as amended, particularly by an Act approved April 16, 1999
3 (Ga. L. 1999, p. 4653), so as to change the provisions relating to the compensation of the
4 chairperson and members of the board; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting
5 laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 An Act creating the board of commissioners of Clayton County, approved February 8, 1955
9 (Ga. L. 1955, p. 2064), as amended, particularly by an Act approved April 16, 1999 (Ga. L.
10 1999, p. 4653), is amended by striking subsection (a) of Section 7 of said Act and
11 substituting in lieu thereof a new subsection (a) to read as follows:

12 "(a) The chairperson of the board shall be compensated in an amount equal to the amount
13 of state salary provided by general law for superior court judges, as such amount may be
14 increased by cost-of-living adjustments, to be paid in equal monthly installments from the
15 funds of Clayton County. The chairperson of the board shall also receive an annual expense
16 allowance of \$5,000.00 per annum payable out of the funds of the county and shall be
17 entitled to a county automobile while engaged in county business."

18 **SECTION 2.**

19 Said Act is further amended by striking subsection (b) of Section 7 of said Act and
20 substituting in lieu thereof a new subsection (b) to read as follows:

21 "(b) Four members of the board other than the chairperson shall be compensated in an
22 amount equal to 16 percent of the amount of state salary provided by general law for
23 superior court judges, as such amount may be increased by cost-of-living adjustments, to
24 be paid in equal monthly installments. Each of the other members of the board shall also

1 receive an annual expense allowance of \$3,000.00 per annum payable in equal monthly
2 installments. These payments shall be made from the funds of Clayton County."

3 **SECTION 3.**

4 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2001.

5 **SECTION 4.**

6 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
