A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Julie Ann Brennan; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Julie Ann Brennan has made many significant contributions to various civic and
3 community service entities in Woodstock and Cherokee County and is a recipient of the
4 Lamar Haley Community Service Award for 2001 from the Rotary Club of Canton; and

5 WHEREAS, she was the Community Events Coordinator for the City of Woodstock,
6 Georgia, where she oversees the many concerts, festivals, parades, and public entertainment
7 offered to the citizenry and manages the details that ensure public safety and enjoyment; and

8 WHEREAS, she is the director of development for the Downtown District of the City of
9 Woodstock and the Mayor's Volunteer Program, promotes the local government activities
10 and functions, and provides a critical service as a Spanish translator to key local officials; and

11 WHEREAS, earlier in her career she served as a public affairs specialist for the United States
12 Naval Station Roosevelt Road, Puerto Rico, and her rich experience in public administration
13 strengthened her public service as a board member of Cherokee County American Cancer

16 Woodstock Women's Society, and President of the Anna Crawford Children's Center
17 Advisory Board and has demonstrated exemplary community awareness and leadership.
