A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To support the national defense by promoting registration of certain Georgia residents with
- 2 the United States Selective Service System as required by federal law; to provide for
- 3 transmittal of information regarding certain persons to the United States Selective Service
- 4 System; to require registration with the United States Selective Service System or consent
- 5 thereto at the time of application of certain persons for issuance or renewal of drivers'
- 6 licenses or identification cards; to amend Article 1 of Chapter 5 of Title 40 of the Official
- 7 Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general provisions relative to motor vehicle drivers
- 8 licenses, so as to provide for the foregoing; to provide legislative findings and declarations;
- 9 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

- 12 The General Assembly finds and declares as follows:
- 13 (1) Military service of citizens of this state in the armed forces of the United States has
- been and will remain a critical contribution to the national defense;
- 15 (2) The United States Selective Service System plays a crucial role in ensuring that the
- nation can rapidly call up citizens for military duty in time of need;
- 17 (3) Certain persons are required by federal law to register with the United States
- 18 Selective Service System;
- 19 (4) Significant and detrimental consequences imposed by law await those who shun their
- 20 duty and fail to register for the United States Selective Service System as required,
- 21 including loss of eligibility for certain government programs and employment; and
- 22 (5) The purpose of this Act is to support the national defense by promoting registration
- of certain Georgia residents with the United States Selective Service System as required
- by federal law.

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25 SECTION 2.

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1 Article 1 of Chapter 5 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to

- 2 general provisions relative to motor vehicle drivers' licenses, is amended in Code Section
- 3 40-5-2, relating to keeping of records of applications for licenses and information on
- 4 licensees and furnishing of information, by striking the introductory language and paragraph
- 5 (1) of subsection (f) and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 6 "(f) The department is specifically authorized to disseminate the following records and
- 7 information:
- 8 (1) To the United States Selective Service System and the Georgia Crime Information
- 9 Center, compilations of the names, most current addresses, license or identification card
- numbers, and dates of birth of licensees or applicants for licenses or applicants for or
- 11 <u>holders of identification cards issued under this chapter, or, in the case of the United</u>
- 12 <u>States Selective Service System, any other information from the license or identification</u>
- card application as necessary for purposes of registration of persons therewith. Such
- information shall only be used in the fulfillment of the legitimate governmental duties of
- the United States Selective Service System and the Georgia Crime Information Center
- and shall not be further disseminated to any person. <u>Information transmitted to the</u>
- 17 <u>United States Selective Service System pursuant to this paragraph shall be provided in</u>
- 18 <u>an electronic format;"</u>.

19 **SECTION 3.**

- 20 Said article is further amended by adding a new Code Section 40-5-7 to read as follows:
- 21 "40-5-7.
- 22 (a) Any male United States citizen or immigrant who applies for any driver's license or
- 23 identification card issued under this chapter, including without limitation any instruction
- 24 permit, limited driving permit, provisional driver's license, or commercial driver's license,
- or for renewal thereof, and who is less than 26 years of age shall be registered in
- 26 compliance with the requirements of Section 3 of the Military Selective Service Act, 50
- 27 App. U.S.C.A. Section 451, et seq., as amended.
- 28 (b) The signature of any applicant described in subsection (a) of this Code section
- 29 submitted to the department in application for such license or identification card issuance
- or renewal shall serve as an indication that the applicant either has registered already with
- 31 the United States Selective Service System or that he is authorizing the department to
- forward to the United States Selective Service System the necessary information for such
- registration. The department shall notify the applicant at the time of application that his
- signature constitutes consent to be registered with the United States Selective Service
- 35 System if he is not already so registered. The department shall, as soon as practical
- 36 following such application and in accordance paragraph (1) of subsection (f) of Code

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1 Section 40-5-2, forward the necessary personal information of the applicant to the United

- 2 States Selective Service System for purposes of registration therewith at such time as
- 3 required by federal law."

4 SECTION 4.

5 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
