

House Bill 141

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 40-6-47 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 one-way roadways and rotary traffic islands, so as to provide for marking of one-way
3 roadways at certain intersections; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and
4 for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Code Section 40-6-47 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to one-way
8 roadways and rotary traffic islands, is amended by striking subsection (a) and inserting in
9 lieu thereof the following:

10 "(a) The Department of Transportation and local authorities with respect to highways
11 under their respective jurisdictions may designate any highway, roadway, part of a
12 roadway, or specific lanes upon which vehicular traffic shall proceed in one direction at all
13 of such times as shall be indicated by official traffic-control devices. Any intersection at
14 which traffic on a roadway so designated for one-way traffic in all lanes is required to stop
15 shall be marked across the width of the one-way roadway by a yellow line with yellow
16 reflectors facing traffic traveling on the one-way roadway in the correct direction and by
17 a red line with red reflectors facing traffic entering the one-way roadway in the wrong
18 direction."

19 **SECTION 2.**

20 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2002.

21 **SECTION 3.**

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
