A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Douglas Blueprint; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, the Douglas Blueprint process originated from the four-year community and
3 economic development effort by the Douglas County Chamber of Commerce called Douglas
4 Emerging with the ultimate aim of strengthening the local economy and enhancing the
5 community's quality of life; and

6 WHEREAS, the Douglas Blueprint process is designed with the objective of addressing the
7 primary economic development issues facing the community and working toward achieving
8 a community vision; and

9 WHEREAS, more than 300 members of the Douglas County community worked to develop
10 the five goals, thirty objectives, and 167 action steps which comprise the Douglas Blueprint
11 strategy; and

12 WHEREAS, the Douglas Blueprint process has involved many individuals who have given
13 unselfishly of their time and talents to make the process work and have spent many hours
14 before, during, and after their normal work hours to make this process a reality; and

15 WHEREAS, this dedication to the betterment of Douglas County and the spirit of
16 cooperation and unity to achieve a common goal of improving the local economy and the
17 quality of life in Douglas County is worthy of recognition and commendation.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that this body recognizes and
19 commends the Douglas Blueprint process and those many citizens of Douglas County who
20 have participated in it for their civic involvement and commitment to the improvement of
21 Douglas County.
