A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Major General Dennis G. Haines; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Major General Dennis G. Haines is the distinguished Commander of the Warner
3 Robins Air Logistics Center at Robins Air Force Base, Georgia, who was appointed to this
4 prestigious military post in February 2000 in recognition of his national reputation; and

5 WHEREAS, he has an impressive history of notable accomplishments, education, and
6 assignments that demonstrate his extraordinary ability and leadership, and his extensive
7 training and experience in engineering, logistics, and management bode well for this key
8 military base and for the countless personnel, civilians, and businesses connected to it; and

9 WHEREAS, Warner Robins ALC has worldwide management responsibility for repair,
10 modification, and overhaul of the F-5 Eagle, the C-30 Hercules, the C-41 Starlifter, the C-5
11 Galaxy, and all Air Force helicopters and provides logistical support for all missiles,
12 vehicles, and the computer, avionics, and electronic systems for most aircraft; and

13 WHEREAS, Robins Air Force Base is one of the most significant and diverse facilities in the
14 U.S. Air Force and is the largest industrial complex in Georgia, and the economic impact of
15 this vital component of our national warfare team across Georgia is \$3.2 billion; and

17 State of Georgia as we acknowledge his very capable direction of this key military post.
