A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and achievements of Susan Landrum; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Susan Landrum was an esteemed resident and leading citizen of Jasper,
3 Georgia; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Ms. Landrum received her juris doctor degree from the University of Georgia
5 School of Law in 1975; and
- 6 WHEREAS, a highly regarded attorney, she practiced with the firm of Landrum and
7 Landrum from 1985 until her death in 2001; and
- 8 WHEREAS, prior to entering the legal profession she served as an assistant professor of
9 political science at Gainesville College after having earned a bachelor's degree from Agnes
10 Scott College and a master's degree from Emory University; and
- 11 WHEREAS, she extended her professional interests to include membership on the Federal
12 Judicial Selection Committee, the Federal Merit Review Panel, the Medical Malpractice
13 Advisory Committee, and the State Personnel Board; and
- 14 WHEREAS, the affairs and well-being of her community were of particular interest to her
15 and she served as chairperson of the Ellijay-Gilmer County Chamber of Commerce,
16 chairperson of the Friends of the Pickens County Library, and trustee of the Carl Vinson
17 Institute of Government; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Susan Landrum was a sportswoman, a family woman, a scholar, and a devoted
19 daughter, sister, and aunt; and
- 20 WHEREAS, she was the daughter of the esteemed former Ninth District U. S. Congressman,
21 the late Phillip M. Landrum.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
2 honor the life and achievements of Susan Landrum and express their appreciation for the
3 excellent service she rendered as an outstanding citizen of the State of Georgia and extend
4 their sincere condolences to her family.
