A RESOLUTION

1 Designating a bridge on SR 52 in Gilmer County as the Carl Dover Memorial Bridge; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Carl Dover was a distinguished farmer, businessman, and citizen of Gilmer
4 County who served for six years as a member of the Gilmer County Board of Education; and

5 WHEREAS, he was a member of the Nine Mile Methodist Church, a Sunday School teacher,
6 a civic leader, a Lions Club member, a Mason, a Shriner, and an ASCS committee chairman;
7 and

8 WHEREAS, he was a loving husband of 38 years and the father of two children; and

9 WHEREAS, he was an inspiration to his family, friends, and the community of which he was
10 a lifelong member; and

11 WHEREAS, it is only fitting and proper that his memory be honored by this state and in the
12 community in which he lived.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 GEORGIA that the Mountaintown Bridge on SR 52 West near the Dover family farm in
15 Gilmer County is hereby designated as the Carl Dover Memorial Bridge, which designation
16 shall supersede any former designation, and the Department of Transportation is authorized
17 and directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs so identifying the bridge.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
19 and directed to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to the Department of
20 Transportation and the family of Mr. Carl Dover.
