## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 47-17-1, relating to definitions relative to the Peace Officers'
- 2 Annuity and Benefit Fund, so as to provide for membership in such fund by fraud
- 3 investigators employed in the fraud and compliance unit of the State Board of Workers'
- 4 Compensation; to provide conditions for an effective date and automatic repeal; to repeal
- 5 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 47-17-1, relating to definitions relative to the Peace Officers' Annuity and
- 9 Benefit Fund, is amended by striking the word "and" at the end of subparagraph (J) of
- 10 paragraph (5), striking the symbol "." at the end of subparagraph (K) and inserting in lieu
- 11 thereof the symbol and word: "; and", and by inserting immediately following such
- subparagraph the following:
- 13 "(L) Fraud investigators employed in the fraud and compliance unit of the State Board
- of Workers' Compensation who are certified in compliance with Chapter 8 of Title 35."

15 SECTION 2.

- 16 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2002, only if it is determined to have been
- 17 concurrently funded as provided in Chapter 20 of Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 18 Annotated, the "Public Retirement Systems Standards Law"; otherwise, this Act shall not
- 19 become effective and shall be automatically repealed in its entirety on July 1, 2002, as
- 20 required by subsection (a) of Code Section 47-20-50.
- 21 SECTION 3.
- 22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
