A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 47-17-1, relating to definitions relative to the Peace Officers' Annuity and Benefit Fund, so as to provide for membership in such fund by fraud investigators employed in the fraud and compliance unit of the State Board of Workers' Compensation; to provide conditions for an effective date and automatic repeal; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Code Section 47-17-1, relating to definitions relative to the Peace Officers' Annuity and Benefit Fund, is amended by striking the word "and" at the end of subparagraph (J) of paragraph (5), striking the symbol "." at the end of subparagraph (K) and inserting in lieu thereof the symbol and word: "; and", and by inserting immediately following such subparagraph the following:

13 "(L) Fraud investigators employed in the fraud and compliance unit of the State Board of Workers' Compensation who are certified in compliance with Chapter 8 of Title 35."

15 **SECTION 2.**

16 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2002, only if it is determined to have been concurrently funded as provided in Chapter 20 of Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, the "Public Retirement Systems Standards Law"; otherwise, this Act shall not become effective and shall be automatically repealed in its entirety on July 1, 2002, as required by subsection (a) of Code Section 47-20-50.

21 **SECTION 3.**

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
