AS PASSED SENATE

**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT**

1 To provide a homestead exemption from City of Conyers ad valorem taxes for municipal
2 purposes in the amount of \$10,000.00 of the assessed value of the homestead for each
3 resident of the City of Conyers, which is in lieu of and not in addition to any other homestead
4 exemption applicable to City of Conyers ad valorem taxes for municipal purposes; to provide
5 for conditions and procedures relating thereto; to repeal a specific Act; to provide for a
6 referendum; to provide for applicability; to provide an effective date and automatic repeal;
7 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

8 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

9 **SECTION 1.**

10 (a) For purposes of this Act, the term:

11 (1) "Ad valorem taxes for municipal purposes" means all ad valorem taxes for municipal
12 purposes levied by, for, or on behalf of the City of Conyers, except for taxes to pay
13 interest on or retire bonded indebtedness.

14 (2) "Homestead" means homestead as defined and qualified in Code Section 48-5-40 of
15 the O.C.G.A.

16 (b) Each resident of the City of Conyers is granted an exemption on that person's homestead
17 from all City of Conyers ad valorem taxes for municipal purposes in the amount of
18 \$10,000.00 of the assessed value of that homestead. The value of the homestead in excess
19 of the amount exempted by this section shall remain subject to taxation.

20 (c) A person shall not receive the homestead exemption granted by subsection (b) of this
21 section unless the person or person's agent files an application with the governing authority
22 of the City of Conyers, or the designee thereof, giving such information relative to receiving
23 such exemption as will enable the tax commissioner to make a determination as to whether
24 such owner is entitled to such exemption.

25 (d) The governing authority of the City of Conyers or the designee thereof shall provide
26 application forms for the exemption granted by subsection (b) of this section and shall

1 require such information as may be necessary to determine the initial and continuing
2 eligibility of the owner for the exemption.

3 (e) The exemption shall be claimed and returned as provided in Code Section 48-5-50.1 of
4 the O.C.G.A. The exemption shall be automatically renewed from year to year as long as the
5 owner occupies the residence as a homestead. After a person has filed the proper application
6 as provided in subsection (c) of this section, it shall not be necessary to make application for
7 any year thereafter and the exemption shall continue to be allowed to such person. It shall
8 be the duty of any person granted the homestead exemption under subsection (b) of this
9 section to notify the governing authority of the City of Conyers, or the designee thereof, in
10 the event that person for any reason becomes ineligible for that exemption.

11 (f) The exemption granted by this Act shall not apply to or affect state ad valorem taxes,
12 county ad valorem taxes for county purposes, or school district ad valorem taxes for
13 educational purposes. The homestead exemption granted by subsection (b) of this section
14 shall be in lieu of and not in addition to any other homestead exemption applicable to
15 municipal ad valorem taxes.

16 (g) The exemption granted by subsection (b) of this section shall apply to all taxable years
17 beginning on or after January 1, 2002.

18 (h) An Act providing a homestead exemption from City of Conyers ad valorem taxes for
19 municipal purposes in the amount of \$7,000.00 of the assessed value of the homestead for
20 each resident of the City of Conyers, approved April 19, 2000 (Ga. L. 2000, p. 3616), is
21 repealed in its entirety effective on January 1, 2001.

22 **SECTION 2.**

23 Unless prohibited by the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended, the election
24 superintendent of the City of Conyers shall call and conduct an election as provided in this
25 section for the purpose of submitting this part to the electors of the City of Conyers for
26 approval or rejection. The election superintendent shall conduct that election on the date of
27 the November, 2001, municipal election and shall issue the call and conduct that election as
28 provided by general law. The superintendent shall cause the date and purpose of the election
29 to be published once a week for two weeks immediately preceding the date thereof in the
30 official organ of the City of Conyers. The ballot shall have written or printed thereon the
31 words:

32 "() YES Shall the Act be approved which provides a \$10,000.00 homestead
33 exemption from certain City of Conyers ad valorem taxes for municipal
34 () NO purposes?"

35 All persons desiring to vote for approval of the Act shall vote "Yes," and those persons
36 desiring to vote for rejection of the Act shall vote "No." If more than one-half of the votes

1 cast on such question are for approval of the Act, it shall become of full force and effect
2 immediately. If the Act is not so approved or if the election is not conducted as provided in
3 this section, the remaining sections of this Act shall not become effective and this Act shall
4 be automatically repealed on the first day of January immediately following that election
5 date. The expense of such election shall be borne by the City of Conyers. It shall be the
6 election superintendent's duty to certify the result thereof to the Secretary of State.

7 **SECTION 3.**

8 Except as otherwise provided in Section 2 of this Act, this Act shall become effective upon
9 its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.

10 **SECTION 4.**

11 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
