

The Senate Education Committee offered the following substitute to SB 205:

LOST

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 50-18-72 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 when public disclosure shall not be required under Article 4 of Chapter 18 of Title 50, so as
3 to exempt disclosure of certain personal information in all records; to provide for related
4 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

6 Code Section 50-18-72 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to when public
7 disclosure shall not be required under Article 4 of Chapter 18 of Title 50, is amended by
8 striking paragraph (11.1) of subsection (a) and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

9 "(11.1) An individual's social security number, mother's birth name, day and month of
10 birth, credit card number, debit card number, bank account information, financial data or
11 information, and insurance or medical information in all personnel records; which may
12 be redacted from such records; provided, however, that, where not otherwise prohibited
13 by law, including without limitation paragraphs (3), (4), (5), (7), (11.2), (12), (13), and
14 (13.1) of this subsection and paragraph (2) of subsection (c) of this Code section, an
15 individual's social security number shall be provided for law enforcement purposes or
16 upon the submission of a written statement of need to a person gathering information as
17 a representative of a news media organization if such statement of need has been
18 submitted to and approved by an administrative law judge pursuant to the provisions of
19 Article 2 of Chapter 13 of Title 50. Such approval shall be in the discretion of the
20 administrative law judge upon a determination that such information is sought for
21 news-gathering purposes and will not be further disseminated or otherwise used for
22 commercial purposes. Dissemination or commercial use of social security numbers
23 obtained pursuant to the provisions of this paragraph shall be punishable as a
24 misdemeanor of a high and aggravated nature;"
