

Senate Resolution 285

A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the memory of John S. Quick; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, John S. Quick was born in 1839 and departed this life in 1925, after having
3 honorably served this state as a member of the Polk County Rangers, Company D, 20th
4 Infantry Regiment, Army of Northern Virginia, from February, 1862, until surrender of that
5 army on April 9, 1865, at Appomattox Courthouse; and

6 WHEREAS, in June, 1901, the Rome Chapter of the United Daughters of the Confederacy
7 bestowed the Southern Cross of Honor upon him in recognition of his service and devotion
8 to duty; and

9 WHEREAS, while his body lies in peace at Pleasant Hope Baptist Church Cemetery in
10 Rome, his name lives forevermore in the hearts of his descendants who cherish his legacy
11 and example; and

12 WHEREAS, it is only fitting and proper that the memory of this Georgian be honored by this
13 body.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
15 honor the memory of John S. Quick for his devotion to duty and service to this state.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
17 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the family of John S. Quick.
