**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT**

1 To amend an Act consolidating the offices of tax collector and tax receiver into the office of
2 tax commissioner of Cobb County, approved February 17, 1949 (Ga. L. 1949, p. 790), as
3 amended, particularly by an Act approved March 30, 2000 (Ga. L. 2000, p. 3578), so as to
4 change the salaries of the tax commissioner and the chief clerk thereof; to provide an
5 effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 An Act consolidating the offices of tax collector and tax receiver into the office of tax
9 commissioner of Cobb County, approved February 17, 1949 (Ga. L. 1949, p. 790), as
10 amended, particularly by an Act approved March 30, 2000 (Ga. L. 2000, p. 3578), is
11 amended by striking subsection (a) of Section 3 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
12 "(a) The tax commissioner shall receive an annual salary of \$63,331.32, to be paid in equal
13 monthly installments from county funds. The tax commissioner shall be allowed one chief
14 clerk whose annual salary shall be paid in equal monthly installments from the funds of the
15 county treasury. The annual salary for the chief clerk shall be \$70,751.23. Any candidate
16 for the office of tax commissioner of Cobb County shall, on the date of qualifying for such
17 office in either a primary or a general election, certify to the judge of the Probate Court of
18 Cobb County the name of the person the candidate shall appoint as chief clerk in the event
19 he or she is elected to the office of tax commissioner of Cobb County; and the person so
20 named shall serve as the chief clerk during the term for which he or she was so named. In
21 the event of the death or removal from office of said chief clerk, the tax commissioner of
22 Cobb County shall have 30 days from said date of death or removal from office of said
23 chief clerk to certify to the judge of the Probate Court of Cobb County the name of the
24 chief clerk to be appointed."

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SECTION 2

2 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
3 without such approval.

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SECTION 3

5 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
