A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating the board of commissioners of Cobb County, approved June 19,
2 1964 (Ga. L. 1964, Ex. Sess., p. 2075), as amended, particularly by an Act approved April
3 19, 2000 (Ga. L. 2000, p. 3840), so as to change the provisions relating to the compensation
4 of the commissioners; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
5 purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 An Act creating the board of commissioners of Cobb County, approved June 19, 1964 (Ga.
9 L. 1964, Ex. Sess., p. 2075), as amended, particularly by an Act approved April 19, 2000
10 (Ga. L. 2000, p. 3840), is amended by striking subsection (a) of Section 8 of the Act and
11 inserting in lieu thereof a new subsection (a) to read as follows:

12 "(a) Commissioners, other than the chairperson, shall be paid as their entire compensation
13 for services as commissioners the sum of \$27,820.00 per annum, payable monthly, to be
14 paid out of the county treasury upon warrants drawn upon the county treasury. The
15 chairperson shall receive as his or her entire compensation the sum of \$55,640.00 per
16 annum, payable monthly, also to be paid out of the county treasury upon warrants drawn
17 upon the county treasury. Except as provided otherwise in this section, the salary so fixed
18 shall constitute the entire compensation from all sources to which said chairperson or any
19 commissioner shall be entitled. The chairperson and the commissioners may be reimbursed
20 for reasonable expenses incurred in carrying out their duties. Such expenses shall include
21 the following:

- 22 (1) Mileage reimbursement for the use of a private automobile while conducting county
23 business;
- 24 (2) Secretarial services, if required, over and above the services normally provided by
25 the county; and

1 (3) Travel and lodging expenses and fees incurred in conjunction with training seminars,
2 conventions, or official county business conducted outside of Cobb County."

3 **SECTION 2.**

4 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
5 without such approval.

6 **SECTION 3.**

7 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
