A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Women for Morris Brown College, Inc., on the occasion of its twentieth
2 anniversary celebration; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Women for Morris Brown College, Inc., was founded by Helen Kilpatrick
4 Threatt, the First Lady, during the college's centennial celebration in 1981; and

5 WHEREAS, more than 150 women graduates representing Morris Brown College, UNCF
6 institutions, and other historically black colleges and universities became charter members;

8 WHEREAS, the founding purpose of Women for Morris Brown, Inc., was to enhance the
9 college's positive image and to promote and support student development financially through
10 scholarship funds and special women's programs; and

11 WHEREAS, thousands of volunteer hours have been given by members in service to special
12 events and mentoring programs sponsored by the organization since its founding in 1981 and
13 thousands of dollars have been presented to the college for scholarships; and

14 WHEREAS, Mrs. Louise T. Hollowell, Mrs. Joyce P. Wyatt, Mrs. Eddye M. Peacock, and
15 Mrs. Eloise P. Burwell have served with great distinction as leaders of the organization over
16 the past years; and

17 WHEREAS, Women for Morris Brown College, Inc., celebrates its twentieth anniversary on
18 Saturday, March 3, 2001; and

19 WHEREAS, the luncheon program will reflect the theme: "Ambassadors for Promoting
20 Excellence As We Go The Distance For Morris Brown College, Our Power Source," in
21 support of Dr. Dolores Cross's Learning Tree Concept.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that this body recognizes and
2 commends Women for Morris Brown College, Inc., on the occasion of its twentieth
3 anniversary celebration and expresses its appreciation for their significant contributions to
