AS PASSED SENATE

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 31-1-9 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 2 breast-feeding of babies, so as to change provisions relating to mothers who breast-feed in
- 3 public places; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 5 SECTION 1.
- 6 Code Section 31-1-9 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 7 breast-feeding of babies, is amended by striking said Code section in its entirety and inserting
- 8 in lieu thereof the following:
- 9 "31-1-9.
- The breast-feeding of a baby is an important and basic act of nurture to which every baby
- has a right and which act must be encouraged in the interests of maternal and child health
- and family values, and in furtherance of this right, a mother may breast-feed her baby in
- any location, where the mother is otherwise authorized to be, provided the mother acts in
- 14 a discreet and modest way."
- 15 SECTION 2.
- 16 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
