AS PASSED SENATE

**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT**

1 To amend Code Section 35-3-36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 duties of state criminal justice agencies as to admission of fingerprints, photographs, and
3 other identifying data to the Georgia Crime Information Center, so as to provide that neither
4 the center or its employees shall be responsible for the accuracy of information contained in
5 records representing wanted persons, missing persons, and stolen serial numbered property
6 established in computerized files on the Georgia criminal justice information system (CJIS)
7 network or in computerized files maintained by the Federal Bureau of Investigation National
8 Crime Information Center (NCIC); to provide that criminal justice agencies establishing such
9 records bear all responsibilities for entry, update, and removal as dictated by actions of
10 criminal justice employees and officials; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

11 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

12 **SECTION 1.**

13 Code Section 35-3-36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to duties of state
14 criminal justice agencies as to admission of fingerprints, photographs, and other identifying
15 data to the Georgia Crime Information Center, is amended by adding at the end thereof a new
16 subsection (n) to read as follows:

17 "(n) Neither the center or its employees shall be responsible for the accuracy of
18 information contained in records representing wanted persons, missing persons, and stolen
19 serial numbered property established in computerized files on the Georgia Criminal Justice
20 Information System (CJIS) network or in computerized files maintained by the Federal
21 Bureau of Investigation National Crime Information Center (NCIC). Criminal justice
22 agencies establishing such records bear all responsibilities for entry, update, and removal
23 as dictated by actions of criminal justice employees and officials."

24 **SECTION 2.**

25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
