## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity was founded at Indiana University at Bloomington,  
3 Indiana, in 1911, and from its inception never excluded college men from membership based  
4 upon color, creed, or national origin; and

5 WHEREAS, Georgia hosts chapters of Kappa Alpha Psi on college and university campuses  
6 and active alumni groups in communities throughout the state; and

7 WHEREAS, Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity is committed to community service and actively  
8 contributes to the educational, civic, and social life of Georgia's citizens; and

9 WHEREAS, alumni chapters encourage their members to become involved community  
10 volunteers and leaders in education, health, economy, and fine arts; and

11 WHEREAS, it is appropriate to honor those social organizations of our society that foster the  
12 principles of equality, tolerance, and community service and to recognize their contributions.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
14 the members of this body recognize Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity and commend the principles  
15 and values endorsed by its members and the exemplary public service of its alumni.
