- 9 WHEREAS, for six years he served on the Peace Officers' Annuity and Benefit Fund; and
- 10 WHEREAS, he was a charter member of the Georgia Sheriffs' Boys Ranch; and
- 11 WHEREAS, it is most fitting that the contributions of Virgil Bledsoe to Heard County as
- 12 Sheriff and to law enforcement in the State of Georgia be recognized and remembered.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
 GEORGIA that the portion of Georgia Highway 34 from the city limits of Franklin, Georgia,
 to the Heard-Coweta County Line is hereby designated as the "Virgil Bledsoe Highway."
