## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 27 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to loitering at or disrupting schools, so as to provide that certain persons entering an
- 3 elementary or secondary school shall promptly inform the principal or other persons in the
- 4 administrative office regarding their presence and provide information regarding their
- 5 purpose; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Article 27 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 9 loitering at or disrupting schools, is amended in Code Section 20-2-1180, relating to loitering
- 10 upon school premises, by inserting a new subsection to read as follows:
- 11 "(c) Upon entering the premises of any elementary or secondary school, any person who
- is not a student at such school or an employee of such school shall promptly inform the
- principal or other persons in the administrative office that he or she is present at the school
- and provide any information requested regarding the purpose of such presence at the
- school."

SECTION 2.

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
