A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Article 27 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,  
2 relating to loitering at or disrupting schools, so as to provide that certain persons entering an  
3 elementary or secondary school shall promptly inform the principal or other persons in the  
4 administrative office regarding their presence and provide information regarding their  
5 purpose; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Article 27 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
9 loitering at or disrupting schools, is amended in Code Section 20-2-1180, relating to loitering  
10 upon school premises, by inserting a new subsection to read as follows:

11 "(c) Upon entering the premises of any elementary or secondary school, any person who  
12 is not a student at such school or an employee of such school shall promptly inform the  
13 principal or other persons in the administrative office that he or she is present at the school  
14 and provide any information requested regarding the purpose of such presence at the  
15 school."

16 **SECTION 2.**

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
