3 distinguished citizens with the untimely passing of Mr. Hugh Wallace Maret; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he was a lifelong resident of Hart County, who devoted his life to his
5 community through his service as co-owner of Hartwell Feed and Elevator and his service
6 on the board of directors of the Bank of Hartwell; and
- 7 WHEREAS, this beloved gentleman was actively involved in the civic, religious, and
8 charitable affairs of his community and gave unstintingly and unceasingly of his time,
9 talents, and energy to improve the quality of life in his community, as dramatically evidenced
10 by his years of service on the Hartwell City Council, the Hart County Board of Education,
11 the Broad River Soil and Water Conservation District Board of Supervisors, and the Hartwell
12 Housing Authority, and by his membership and work in the Hartwell First Methodist Church,
13 Hartwell Kiwanis Club, and Hart County Chamber of Commerce; and

15 and diplomacy, his keen sense of vision, and his acute sensitivity to the needs of the citizens
16 of his community earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and associates; and

18 unfillable void in the hearts and lives of his family and friends.

20 the members of this body express their deepest and most sincere regret at the passing of Mr.
21 Hugh Wallace Maret.
