A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 33 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 general provisions regarding insurance, so as to require certain insurers to provide a loss
3 history to an insured under certain circumstances; to provide an effective date; to repeal
4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Chapter 1 of Title 33 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
8 provisions regarding insurance, is amended by adding a new Code section at the end thereof,
9 to be designated Code Section 33-1-18, to read as follows:

10 "33-1-18.

11 In the event of cancellation or nonrenewal of any commercial insurance policy, the insurer
12 shall be required to provide to the insured or the insured's current agent of record a written
13 loss history within 45 days of the date of such cancellation or nonrenewal."

14 **SECTION 2.**

15 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
16 without such approval.

17 **SECTION 3.**

18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
